Hack Hack Hack

I have been hearing from many parishioners that they have been receiving text messages claiming to be from me. The texts ask for a response and then ultimately financial support or the purchase of gift cards or other such items. Again, please do not believe such requests. This is part of a larger scam that is making its way across the country. It is not just the Catholic Churches and not just in Wichita, but it is country wide and encompasses all churches and faith communities. Those trying to perpetrate the scam will get phone numbers and names from websites for different parishes or churches. They will use the pastor's name because people tend to trust the pastor of their church. They will attempt to get money in any way that they can so beware. I am sorry that you must deal with the scams, but I guess it is a sign of the electronic age. Those that are familiar with such scams say there is little to be done about the problem. The scammers can set up the scam and take it down before anyone can find out who or where they are. Please be vigilant and know that neither I nor anyone connected with St. Michael's Parish would ever ask for money or donations in this way.

Spring Cleaning

We are making a concerted effort to clean up some things around our parish facilities. Several have volunteered to help with these various projects. There are a few areas around the parish facility that are used for storage. The church basement and the outside storage shed to name a couple. It has been years that some of these items have been used. If they are not going to be used, it is silly to have them take up space and collect dust. To help with this project, I would like to enlist your aid. If you lead or participate in an organization or ministry in the parish and you have items stored around the parish facilities, will you either call us at the office and let us know, or make sure those items that are stored are marked with the name of your ministry or organization. Prayer Line Requests

To protect the privacy of others, we ask that prayers for individuals on the prayer lines are limited to requests from family members only. This ensures two things. First, that one's privacy is protected. Second, that the family members and close relatives may learn that their loved one has passed away or that they are suffering an illness from another family member prior to hearing about it via the public prayer line. Finding a loved one is in the hospital or may have died can be a rude awakening if it is learned from a public prayer line rather than through one's family. Thanks for your willingness to pray for others. When you do so, you are following the example of Christ in offering this act of mercy.
