### **Youth Mission Trip**

I want to welcome back our youth and chaperones that went on the mission trip this year. I have heard great reports about your time in Milwaukee. Know that we are proud that you are willing to spend time in helping others. I also want you to know that when you are away you are missed. The parish is not the same without you. You may not realize it, but you add life to the parish. Thanks for being willing to share your time and talent traveling to help others. But also, thank you for coming home, it is always good to have you back.

### **It's a family thing!**

I am going to reveal something that you come to learn rather quickly as a priest, and as you are assigned to a parish. A priest quickly gets accustomed to his parish and his parishioners. The first thing you learn is that parishioners tend to attend the same Mass and usually sit in the same pew or same area of the church each week. However, there are travelers, the handful that never sit in the same place. Each week it's like they defy you to find them there in the congregation. Guess what, you are always found! The next thing the priest learns is that each parish, and in fact each Mass has its own personality, just as individuals have their own personality. One Mass may have better singers, another Mass seems to be more attentive, another Mass is always antsy to get out early, sometimes there are Masses when it seems all the young ones are having a bad day, some Masses are filled with good parishioners that at least act like the priest's jokes are funny. You tend to expect different Masses to react differently, just as you know members of your own family react differently to different situations.

It all boils down to the fact that our parish is our extended family. I mention this because when a large group of parishioners, like the youth going on the mission trip, or, groups or families are away for various activities or even if they attend Mass at a different time, you are missed. We miss not seeing you each week. When we notice some are not here, we worry that something may have happened, or we are happy because we know they are off having a good time traveling or on vacation. Sometimes we think of them because we know they are not well or know that they are having a hard time of things. We begin to expect that people will be there, we expect them to react in a certain way. It is good that we grow together as a family, it should give us comfort that others think of us and are concerned for our well-being. Most important though is that we pray for each other. We remember in prayer those family members that are struggling, those that are doing well, those that have accomplished great things and yes, we even pray for those that might drive us crazy. We are very fortunate to have a great family here at St. Michael the Archangel Parish. We should feel good being a member of the St. Michael the Archangel family. We feel good as we pray for the good times and the difficult times. We pray for each other. It's a family thing!
