I do, however, want you to know that your stewardship is appreciated. Just to let you know in the past weeks we have received notes from several diocesan ministries and other Catholic organizations, the Guadalupe Clinic, Villa Maria, Center of Hope to name a few. These organizations have sent thanks for various gifts of time, talent and treasure that they have received from our parish and from you, our parishioners. Your generosity abounds and is evident through your tithing and through your gifts to things like our emergency fund, through volunteering for the Apostle Build, through work and dedication to the Lord's Diner, and many, many, more worthy endeavors.

I do not think anyone realizes all the work that goes on "behind the scenes" that makes our parish what and who we are. We don't realize that every week parishioners straighten the books and pick up left-overs from the pews. We have parishioners that pick-up trash that is blown onto the property. Parishioners pull weeds or trim and care for plants in front of the church. Arrangements of flowers appear at the altar and the statues. Pamphlets and books are straightened and put in order in the vestibule. New parishioners are welcomed. Baptismal classes are held and gifts from the parish are prepared. Coffee and donuts appear each Sunday. Knights prepare breakfast. Altar society makes sure parish events run smoothly and that we have all we need to celebrate the sacraments. Things around the parish magically get fixed, cleaned, replaced and put in order without anyone asking or saying a word. It would be impossible to list all the things that take place to keep things running smoothly. No one, not even the pastor and the staff know all who take care of the little and not so little things around the parish. This is not even mentioning the things that we see getting done, servers serving at Mass, lectors reading, extraordinary ministers distributing communion, sacristans setting up for Mass. The list can go on and on.
